Whatcouldbedone?Asylum seekers, the majority from the Russian republic of Chechnya and Central Asia, who arrived at the Polish-Belarus border crossing were routinely denied the right to access the Polish asylum procedure, and summarily returned

to Belarus. Furthermore, being a refugee greatly shortens the naturalization process, should the person wish to obtain French citizenship.
